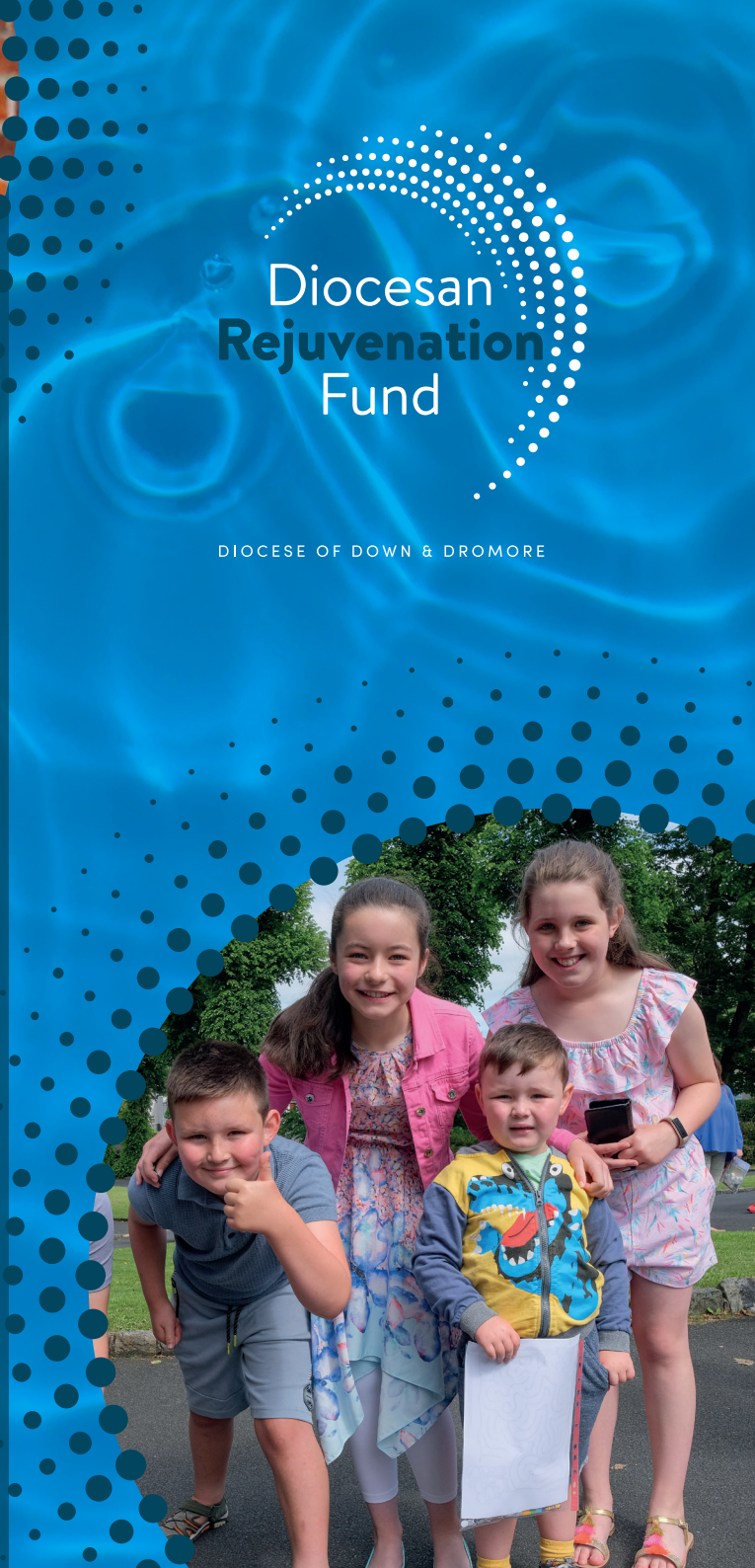

What is church rejuvenation?

Rejuvenation involves a church renewing its focus on ministries and evangelistic outreach and:

- Entering a new season of ministry fruitfulness and;
- Being an active witness in its local community for generations to come.

Churches can go through challenging seasons characterised by a decline in:

- Attendance
- Baptisms and conversions
- Financial giving
- Volunteering in ministries
- Community engagement

What is the Diocesan Rejuvenation Fund?

Announced at the Diocesan Bible Week in September 2021.

Aim - to enable the diocese to better support churches which are committed to revitalisation of their ministries and outreach.

How is the Fund supported?

Regular or one-off donations from individuals or organisations that would like to partner in this important revitalisation work.

Assignment of a proportion of the annual allocations the diocese receives from parishes.

How will funding be allocated?

The diocese will partner with parishes committed to rejuvenation of their ministries and outreach by:

- Making grants that match funds that the parish has raised to reenergise its ministries and outreach.

Grants will be for a fixed term (*not exceeding 2 years*) and made on 30 November each year.

Applications will outline the:

- Need for the initiative
- Aims of the initiative
- Action plan to rejuvenate their ministries/outreach
- Leadership of the rejuvenation
- Budget
- Need for diocesan support
- Plans to enable the ministry or outreach to become sustainable
- Funding allocated by the parish to support this initiative

Where parishes receive financial support from the Diocesan Rejuvenation Fund:

- The church leader will participate in Diocesan Ministry Leaders' Days.
- A written report on the progress of the Rejuvenation Initiative will be submitted by 30 September of the following year.
- The lessons learned from their Rejuvenation Initiative will be shared with other parishes.
